

CREATING SPACE FOR FAMILIES

At Mercy Housing Northwest (MHNW), we believe that a lack of financial resources should not determine someone's ability to access stable, affordable housing. In 2018, you supported us as we moved closer than ever to this vision by embracing



three main opportunities – creating space for families in Seattle; making a significant dent in family homelessness; and making our communities more equitable.

We got closer to our goal of adding nearly 500 affordable familysized homes in Seattle in the next few years. Construction is winding down at Mercy Magnuson Place – converted naval barracks at Sand Point – and families begin moving in spring of 2019.

We broke ground, with much fanfare, on the Mount Baker Family Housing and Resource Center, designed as a supportive place for parents and children who are currently experiencing homelessness or are at risk of becoming homeless. We launched a collaborative of service partners – Mary's Place, Child Care Resources, and Refugee

Women's Alliance – who are committed to working side-by-side at this Family Resource Center once it opens. I draw inspiration from the late Paul Allen, who funded the project with a \$30 million donation. He said, "As long as we work together with both urgency and determination, there are no limits to what we can achieve."

Our board and staff renewed their commitment to racial justice and equity with a racial equity plan. Each department launched new ideas and creative solutions, and it produced significant results. We reduced language barriers for residents to participate in onsite programs, created more opportunities for people of color to advance in real estate development and property management fields, and ensured the inclusive design of future MHNW properties. It also showed us how much more work we must do to achieve a truly just society and energized us to look harder and think more deeply in 2019.

We invite you to reflect on the past year and to look ahead to the future of what we can achieve together.

Hats Off! Mercy Othello Plaza celebrated its first graduating Pre-K class of 13 kids – both residents and youth from the surrounding community. This onsite kindergarten readiness program is offered through our partner, East African Community Services. The program was such a success that the class is being offered again in 2019, with 12 more youth enrolled.

Action for Equity! We launched an initiative to promote racial equity in all programs, projects, and operations. We collaborated with housing partners to advance racial justice, incorporated national best practices on racial equity and inclusion, and each department created strategic workplans with racial equity goals.

Collaboration at Mercy Magnuson Place! Funding from the Congregation of Sisters of Mercy in Ireland and Enterprise Community Partners set the stage for a collaborative with local schools and partners to support academic success among youth residents at our new development, Mercy Magnuson Place. Formerly naval barracks in the Magnuson Park campus, Mercy Magnuson Place will have 148 affordable homes with an onsite childcare center and health clinic. It's set to open in spring 2019.

Breaking Ground! The community celebrated as we broke ground on the Mount Baker Family Housing and Resource Center, which will support families and children who are currently homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. In addition to a large gift from the late Paul Allen, the Seattle Seahawks adopted the project for a big game and helped raise over \$50K through a Home Field Advantage Campaign. Residents, Renee and her kids, joined the Seahawks on gameday!

Thriving Community! The Eleanor Apartments in Bellingham celebrated its first anniversary in December. Through a partnership with YMCA, we offer seniors an Enhance Fitness class three days a week, and this is just one of the many classes provided by a full roster of onsite health and wellness activities. Thirty-nine senior residents participated in a total of 164 physical fitness classes.

A Gift of Hope

Thankful for her second chance, Samona is determined to uplift the spirit of her community, just as the community at Mercy Housing did for her when she needed it most

Samona, a mother of 11-year-old twins, was born in Seattle but grew up in New York City. She returned home to Seattle to make amends with her mother, but their rocky relationship left her and her children without a place to call home in an unfamiliar place. One day, she met a woman who told her about Mercy Housing Northwest's community in Columbia City - she went immediately, knowing she had to find a place for her family. The first thing she noticed when she arrived was a beautiful sign, "Mercy Housing." Filled with emotion, she thought that maybe this was a place she could call home. That same day she found out that a two-bedroom had just become available. Samona instantly asked to view it. After applying, she was accepted and moved in just weeks later. As her family settled into their new home, they got to know their neighbors and fell in love with the community. She was finally able to refocus and look ahead to the future, now that her family had a stable place to call home.

Samona had no idea her life would quickly be turned upside down by a phone call she received from her doctor. As she stood outside the apartment building, she learned that her MRI results showed a brain tumor. If it wasn't removed, Samona would have six months to live. With tears in her eyes, all that she could remember after the call was looking up at the word "mercy" on the Mercy Housing sign. It gave her a sense of comfort, despite her overwhelming fear of what lay ahead.

Samona was determined to fight so that she could be there for her kids' futures.

After the fateful surgery, she faced learning to speak and walk again. Her neighbors cheered her on as she relearned how to walk in the halls of her apartment building. She had a supportive community who gave her hope. During her recovery, she was unable to leave the apartment. Samona was incredibly thankful for the support of her community and neighbors, as well as the weekly onsite Resident Services programs, which played a significant role in her successful recovery.

Samona was determined to give back, and she reached out to Othello Tiny House Village in hope of sponsoring holiday gifts for 50 residents. With overwhelming community support, she found sponsors for over 500 families! Samona organized her second holiday gift effort for families and individuals of tiny house villages and tent cities across Seattle. The event was hosted at Mercy Housing's Othello Plaza community room. Individuals and vendors in the community helped donate gifts and services, including free haircuts. A local company provided shoes and coats for all the families. This past year's Gifts of Hope holiday efforts served 862 individuals!

In 2019, Gifts of Hope will officially become a nonprofit organization, making Samona's dream a reality.




