childcare resources

Brightspark staff is on site five days a week to help families applying for childcare subsidies. Kaleidoscope Play and Learn sessions take place twice each week. Pathways to Progress Alliance (PPA) provides culturally responsive early childhood development, family support, and youth programs for immigrant and refugee families from the African Diaspora and other underserved communities. PPA staff is on-site three times a week for community outreach, offers monthly workshops, and provides 1:1 case management to support families and youth.

housing services

Services for families experiencing housing insecurity, including shelter referral, housing support, and social service navigation.

basic necessities

Cold weather supplies, hygiene tools, pantry staples, snacks, diapers, and more for children and adults! Fresh food boxes are available on the first Monday/Tuesday of the month.

health and wellness activities

Monthly, free health and wellness workshops for parents and families. Call or visit the AFC for schedule.
